

## Transportation Delays Due To Hazardous Weather

Winter is quickly approaching which often brings inclement weather and the possibility of hazardous road conditions for buses. There are certain locations within the district that become difficult to travel when weather becomes inclement.

In the event that we experience such conditions, and deem it safest to run buses on snow routes, the following roads will not be traveled. A snow route stop has been listed below for each road that will not be traveled:



- \* **Allen Rd** Rte 4 pick-up and drop off on Middle Fork 7:20 & 4:10
- \* **August Rd** Rte 1 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 7:25 & 3:40  
(Includes: Four Seasons, Highlander Rd, Summer Run Dr. and Starlight Dr.)
- \* **Clark Rd** Rte 2 pick-up and drop off on Gish Rd 7:35 & 3:45  
(Includes: Ricky Lane)
- \* **Guerrier Rd** Rte 4 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 6:50 & 3:40  
(Includes: Moseley Rd and Briar Rose Lane)
- \* **Hyak Rd** Rte 4 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 6:30 & 3:30
- \* **Oppelt Rd** Rte 3 pick-up and drop off on Centralia-Alpha 7:20 & 4:40
- \* **Short Rd** Rte 3 pick-up and drop off on Centralia-Alpha 6:45 & 3:55
- \* **Stub Rd** Rte 1 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 7:30 & 3:30  
(Includes: Hockett Rd)
- \* **Tillie Rd** Rte 6 pick-up and drop off on Burnt Ridge Rd 7:15 & 4:25  
(Includes: Michael Ln)
- \* **Walhaupt Rd** Rte 2 will pick-up and drop off on Leonard 7:15 & 3:30
- \* **Wirsdorfer Rd** Rte 3 pick-up and drop off on Centralia-Alpha 6:50 & 3:40

Students on the specified roads will be picked-up in the morning and dropped off in the afternoon at the **alternate bus stop** each day snow routes are in effect. **Please Note:** Times are approximate. Actual times will fluctuate due to overall road and weather conditions. An automatic phone alert will be sent out each morning buses will be traveling on snow routes. Please make sure you have a current phone number listed with your child/children's school office. The notice will also be reported to the following media networks:
