Onalaska School District qualifies for Title I Funding. According to ESEA, all schools receiving funding from Title I must notify parents that they may request information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teachers. This information is readily available and may be requested in writing at each respective school.

Schools/districts must also notify patrons/parents that teachers must meet both state certification requirements and federal requirements as indicated in the Elementary and Secondary Education (ESEA) Act.

The Onalaska School District has reported all teachers but one teacher as meeting both state certification requirements and federal requirements as indicated in the Elementary and Secondary Education (ESEA) Act. The district will follow the regulations and not hire any teachers that are not designated as "highly qualified". In the Onalaska School District, Mr. Saade is working toward "Highly Qualified" status. He has a Washington State certificate and the district has confidence in his ability as a classroom teacher.
